Peer Tutor Application 2016-2017

The [PRIME STEM](#) program is designed to provide opportunities for academic development and to motivate students toward the successful completion of their college education. With funding from the United States Department of Education TRIO Student Support Services (SSS) grant, UCF has created a customized program for 120 students pursuing a degree in the Sciences, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) and health sciences. The PRIME STEM program addresses the academic and social needs of eligible students enrolled at UCF who are first-generation in college, have a documented disability, or demonstrate financial need.

Position: Peer Tutor (3 positions)

Approximately 8 hours per week.

Pay rate is \$8.50 per hour.

The position will officially begin in mid-August with a half-day training tentatively scheduled for August 18th or 19th and will last through Spring 2017 with the possibility of continuation for the next academic year if desired.

Qualifications:

For consideration, candidates must possess the following qualifications.

- Minimum grade point average of 3.5
- Junior or Senior level, (other qualified applicants may be considered)
- Strong interpersonal skills
- Knowledge of their major and college
- Knowledge of university academic resources
- Ability to use a variety of study aids
- Ability to work well with others
- Positive attitude
- Comfortable presenting to groups
- Must have a B or higher in the course being tutored

Responsibilities:

Peer Tutors will:

- Tutor a math (i.e. Trig, Pre-Calculus, Calculus) or science subject
- Establish coaching relationship with PRIME STEM tutees
- Implement study skills techniques
- Complete bi-weekly tutor reports
- Assist with program publications and workshops
- Other duties as assigned

Please complete the attached application, submit a copy of your resume, and a recommendation letter from a UCF faculty member to Amy Bickel, Assistant Director, PRIME STEM in Howard Phillips Hall 208. Applications received by April 29th will be given priority evaluation.
