This position provides support to the Student Development and Enrollment Services TRiO Center through work with students in groups and one-on-one to help them develop effective learning strategies and to become self-regulated learners that achieve academic success. The PRIME STEM program is housed in the <u>SDES TRiO Center</u> and serves 120 STEM majors (including Health Sciences).

Job Responsibilities:

- Provide students with skills and strategies they may need to become self-regulated learners.
- Help students understand and use effective learning strategies.
- Help students identify and overcome obstacles that may be impeding academic success.
- Help students focus on individual goals and identify steps to reaching those goals.
- Work with students to develop strong time-management and organization.
- Motivate students to take ownership of their own academic success.
- Monitor student progress.
- Refer students to other services on campus such as academic advising, personal or career counseling, tutoring, or other services.
- Documenting coaching sessions
- Developing online or in-person workshops on any of the topics or skills mentioned above
- Perform other duties as assigned
