- Turn weaknesses into success

- Use detailed, actual examples from your real life
- PROOFREAD, PROOFREAD, PROOFREAD
- Tell a story

DON'T

- Open your essay with a quote
- Use sentences like: "In this essay I will"
- · Use words that are new to you
- Achievement-stuff your essay
- Don't repeat your resume
- Say that you need money outright
- Have the EXACT same essay for every application -- tailor your essays

STUDENT SPOTLIGHT




Asia Lowe


